Beautiful solid Oak hard-wood. Built before 1959. Make an offer and it's yours. All funds go towards our Accessibility Project.

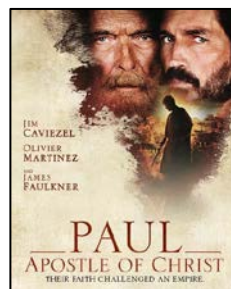
