Advocate for Kingswood University - They Need Our Voice

Since 1945 Kingswood University (Sussex, NS) has proudly been the Wesleyan Church's Canadian place of preparation for ministry. The Federal Government of Canada has recently altered the process for US students coming to Canada for University. This Is a significant setback for Kingswood. **Read their memo:**

The Federal government has decided to restrict new international undergraduate student visas. What you may not have realized is the significant negative impact this will have on Kingswood University.

For this coming year, we have been allotted fewer spots for new international students than we enrolled last year. And last year we were still rebuilding from the hit we took with border closures during the pandemic.

To make matters worse, the government has chosen to include American students in these restrictions. Even students from border states will have to go through the same process as those from abroad. Thankfully, these restrictions do not impact graduate students, so our partnership with Crandall University should not be affected. Also, this only impacts new students, so current American and international students can continue their studies.

We need your help. Would you please consider taking the following action steps:

• Ask your Member of Parliament to intervene to either postpone this decision or at least exempt American students;

• Pray that we have wisdom to know how to continue our growth trajectory;
