#### **Our Grace-Filled God**

This past Wednesday I travelled with Pastor John & Julia Buttigleg and a member of their congregation to the "Wesley Conference" at Tyndale University. It was a good day of learning and fellowship. The keynote speaker was Dr. Jessica LaGrone. She had two powerful sessions where she taught us about the interconnectedness of scripture and how that can help us as pastors effectively preach and teach. In one session she spoke about the Prodigal Son from Luke 15:11-32 and how it would have reminded the first hearers of the reunion between Jacob and Esau in Genesis 32. In both cases, there was a walk of shame as Jacob approached Esau in repentance and also as the prodigal son returned home. If you recall the story of the prodigal son, he requested his inheritance early, in effect saying to his father; "I wish you were dead." In that culture, if someone were to walk through your village who had done something so awful, they would be publicly shunned and shamed. When the prodigal son "came to his senses" (Luke 15:17) he decided to return home. He knew he would have to endure the walk of shame. But we read this amazing verse in Luke 15:20; "But while [the prodigal son] was still a long way off, his father saw him and was filled with compassion for him; he ran to his son, threw his arms around him and kissed him." (Luke 15:20). The father not only forgave him, but saved him from the walk of shame, running

to him while he was still a long way off and before the community had a chance to hold him accountable. Many may have been ready to shame the prodigal son, but instead they witnessed the love and forgiveness of the father.

If you ever think you've gone too far, did too much, and are beyond saving, remember this image. This is Jesus. Our grace-filled God will run to you, releasing you from guilt and protecting you from shame. PTL!
