Overflowing with Praise

This past Sunday we celebrated the Resurrection of Jesus. It was a day of praise! Let's be honest, though, sometimes we don't feel like praising. We might know in our heads that there's hope, but our hearts say something else. The issue might not be our hearts but our "inputs". Psalm 119:171 says; "May my lips overflow with praise, for you teach me your decrees." For praise to overflow, there has to be something flowing into your life that fills you up that can't help but spill over the top...overflowing. If you find yourself struggling with having a heart of praise, I encourage you to look at what is flowing into your life.

This week I heard an interview with Jason Woodruff from "The Pour Over". "The biggest news of the day, summarized in a way you'll actually understand and enjoy, paired with brief Christian perspectives." Very interesting! (You can check it out here: www.thepourover.org)

He encouraged us to listen to just enough news to be informed, and to know how to pray, and then turn it off and get to know Jesus better (either by prayer or serving, for instance). For many, however, they keep the news station on ALL DAY. No wonder the overflow of our lives isn't praise. This is just one example, but it leads to my question for us today; how will you fill your

life with good, godly things so you overflow with praise today?
