Seeking Out the Seekers

When a person comes to you, asking questions about your faith, sometimes we call these people "seekers"? I've talked with people who don't really know much about Jesus or the scriptures, but on some level, they know there's answers found there, so they ask? We want to be ready for seekers. As 1 Peter 3:15 reminds us; "...Always be prepared to give an answer to everyone who asks you to give the reason for the hope that you have....". I love how personal this verse is. It doesn't say "you need to be an expert in the scriptures so you're ready for their questions", but rather, it says, "give the reason for the hope that you have." You ARE the expert of your story!

We want to be ready when seekers come to us, but Jesus reminds us of something else when he said in Luke 19:10; "For the Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost." In this verse, Jesus is doing the seeking OF the seeker. He's looking for them because they are lost. They might not even know it, but without the hope of Christ, we are all lost.

Yes, the Holy Spirit is at work in people before we ever get there. We call this prevenient grace (prevenient means preceding in time or order).

He's seeking the lost. But we are called to be part of this seeking! Are we putting ourselves where lost people are? Are we bringing our hope story into hopeless places? We welcome the lost when they come, but we also need to go where they are.

Let's seek out the seekers!

Children's Ministry Update

We are working at (re)launching Children's Church in the near future. Our goal is to offer a simple lesson and activity to school age children up to age 10, dismissed from our Sunday Service to the foyer right before the sermon. The children would take part in the service in the

sanctuary up until that point. **BUT WE'RE NOT READY YET.**

In the meantime we have activity clip boards available in the foyer for children to use at their seat or parents can sit with their child at the children's table in the foyer. Please do not leave your child unattended, or with someone who is not their parent/guardian. We are asking children/tweens/teens (however you like to refer to yourselves) age 11 and up to please stay in the service.

We want to minister to the whole family in a safe environment, in Jesus' name. Because the children's table is in the foyer, and there is a large window into the sanctuary as well as frequent traffic in and out of the foyer, we can safely run this program with one screened adult volunteer each Sunday.
