GRACE Is...

Have you ever noticed that when we talk about grace, we often feel the need to define it. Some scholars experimented with changing it to the word "kindness" to help people understand. But that did not sit well with many, and they changed it back to grace. Yes, grace is God's kindness, but it's so much more. I wonder if it often needs defining not because it's confusing, but because of how deep in meaning it is. Last Sunday we read Acts 15:10-11; "Now then, why do you try to test God by putting on the necks of Gentiles a voke that neither we nor our ancestors have been able to bear? No! We believe it is through the grace of our Lord Jesus that we are saved, just as they are."" (Acts 15:10-11). We are saved not because of our works, but because of grace. As the song "Reckless Love" by Cory Asbury puts it; "I couldn't earn it. I don't deserve it, still You give yourself away." We will keep coming back to grace, because it is our life-line. Unmerited favour. God's Riches at Christ's Expense. Undeserved. Just a few windows into this beautiful word which extends eternal life tomorrow and eternal purpose today to all who say "yes" to it. When we think "I've gone too far", the grace of Jesus reaches even there.

But perhaps the more challenging aspect of this word is this; God wants us now to be conduits of

His grace to others. God's kindness, forgiveness and love offered to those around us who also don't deserve it. Who better to share it than those who have experienced it for themselves!
