# I went to Sunday School growing up, and one Sunday we sang "this little light of mine". I'll bet you are humming the tune right now. I was with a group of kids at the front singing loud and doing the actions; "Hide it under a bushel, 'no', I'm gonna let it shine." We raised our hands high with that finger pointed upward representing our light. The problem was, I had the WRONG finger raised (you can guess which one). I was too young to understand, but it made for some

Ephesians 5:13 says; "But everything exposed by the light becomes visible—and everything that is illuminated becomes a light." Earlier, in verse 8 we are encouraged to "live as children of light". When we let the light of Christ shine into our lives, it can do two things. First, it exposes the things in our lives that are not pleasing to God (and not helpful for us!). It's hard to live as children of light if we allow darkness in our lives, so God wants to help us get rid of the darkness. Would we be so bold to pray; "God, shine your light into my life." The second thing light does is shine for others to see. I like how verse 13 puts it; "everything that is illuminated becomes a light". Could it be that these two aspects of light are linked, because when we let God's light into our lives, that vulnerability can't help but let

others know how they too can live as children of light and find freedom from the darkness. Once illuminated, we become a light that points right to the source of light. Jesus said in John 8:12; "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness, but will have the light of life."

I pray you walk in the light of Christ today!
